**03.109(i) – Footpath 14**

Cllr Simpson advised that the caravan had now been moved from the footpath.

**04.42(i) – Fencing**

The Lengthsmans has not yet undertaken these repairs. Cllr Simpson will chase up.

**04.52 – Playing Fields**

Cllr Jebb has advised that she will look into the current position regarding our grant application and advise accordingly.

**04.62 – Footpath 12**

Mr Lawlor and Mr Percival-Hughes from the County Council have undertaken a site visit and agreed a way forward. Cllr Simpson will monitor the situation.

**04.73(i) – Obscured sign**

Mr Pytlik has advised that the removal of vegetation from this sign is not an issue for the Highways Department and suggested that the Lengthsman undertake the work. Cllr Simpson will clarify the situation with Mr Pytlik.

**04.73(v) – Ditch by the Ford**

The Highways Department has advised that this ditch will be inspected and cleared accordingly. Cllr Simpson will liaise with Mr Pytlik to undertake a site visit of the whole area.

**04.73(vi) – Boundary Sign**

Mr Pytlik has informed that this work will be put in hand.

- i. Cllr Lawley advised that kerbstones had been damaged at the top of Manor Road / School Road. The gully in this vicinity is also blocked. Cllr Simpson will liaise with Mr Ptylik to ensure remedial work is put in hand.
- ii. Cllr Hewson reported some flying tipping and Cllr Simpson agreed to follow up
- iii. A resident had expressed concerns to Councillors regarding the unsightly parking of vehicles on Clewlow Bank. Cllrs Ralphs was asked to look into this matter.
