06.49(ii) – Well on Thorney Edge Lane

Cllr Hayes reported that he had written to the Parish Council's Solicitors asking them to proceed with the action against Mr McKenzie for the costs involved in the rectification of the well.

07.48(ii) – Bin by the Ford

Cllr Pearson reported that he had been in touch with Mr Drage, Staffordshire Moorlands District Council, and agreement had been reached on the supply of a new waste bin and the existing stone receptacle being converted to form a map of Bagnall. Cllr Simpson was asked to provide a suitable template for the design of the map.

07.77(i) – Bagnall Road – Local Action Group

Cllr Hayes reported that as requested by the Parish Council, he had written to Mr Mark Forrester of Staffordshire Moorlands District Council to complain about the lack of liaison between District Council and the Parish Council concerning the implications of the ill-thought out scheme. He had received a reply from Mr Forrester and distributed copies which would be discussed in full at the next meeting.

07.95(i) – Pot Hole Road Repairs

Cllr Simpson advised that he had spoken with Mr Barry Moss, Staffordshire County Council Highways Department, who had promised that action would be forthcoming.
